

Tavy, Walkham and Plym Fishing Club

River Tavy Beat 5 - Abbey Beat Reserved water 2.6k

The 2.6 kilometres of fishing is double banked and is available to full members at any time and associate members according to the calendar rotation. The beat starts below the boundary wall of Buckland Abbey (National Trust) - about 500 metres below Denham Bridge. It ends at Lopwell Dam. There are two access gates to the left bank. One is on the bend below Denham and cars may be driven about 600 metres to a junction with another track. Driving beyond here is difficult but there is room to park two cars. The Top Track is accessed through a gate about 600 yards back up the hill to Crapstone. Parking for a number of cars can be found inside the gate and a number of places along the track. Right at the end where there is a turning circle. The top track is a better than the lower one but conditions change with the weather and its use by forestry vehicles. **Use all tracks with extreme care.**
